

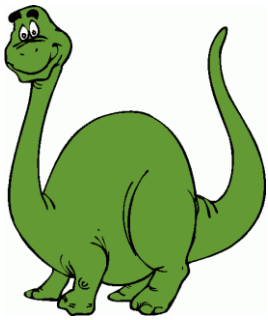
Infant and Toddler May Newsletter

Weather and Clothing

Signing In and Out

Please remember to sign your children in and out every day. It is important for the staff to be able to keep track of the children and the attendance.

Diapers for Children

A reminder for families: During our day we have three regular diaper changes. This means that your child(ren) use AT LEAST 15 diapers per week. This is also not taking any accidents or extra changes needed into consideration. The staff recommend that you have 17-20 diapers at the centre for your child(ren) per week.

Reminder about Illness

In the event your child(ren) is experiencing a fever of 100 degrees (38 degrees Celsius), vomiting or having diarrhea, they will be asked to be picked up from the centre. Once they have been picked up it is the centres policy that they must not attend the centre until they have been symptom free for 24 hours. In the case of fever they must be symptom free for 24 hours without the aid of over the counter medication (Advil, Tylenol etc.)

Spring Walks

We have started taking the toddlers on more walks. During these walks we are teaching the toddlers about safety. Some of the concepts we cover are, looking both ways before crossing the street, holding hands, staying with the group and walking with your friends to make sure no one is left behind.
