

# Invitation extended to take a bike ride with David Suzuki

Take a ride with an environmentally correct Suzuki this month when Dr. David Suzuki makes his last stop on his "If you were prime minister" tour.

As part of his visit to Victoria, Suzuki has agreed to bike the last kilometre of his trip with local riders, said Roberta Martell, executive director of the Fernwood Neighbourhood Resource Group, which is hosting the last date on the tour.

Martell is challenging adults and school groups to join the ride from the cenotaph at the corner of the legislature grounds to Mile 0 on Wednesday, Feb. 28, beginning at 9:30 a.m. and ending around 10 a.m.

That afternoon Suzuki will speak at the First Metropolitan United Church from noon to 1:30 p.m.

During the 50-city tour that started Feb. 1, Suzuki is asking the audience for their ideas, which he's promising to take to Ottawa.
